Interpretation of Grade in myNeosho Procedure

Nursing students are able to monitor their performance status by logging into their *myNesoho* and clicking on the gradebook tab on the left side of the screen. This will open to the students' current grade status as seen below.

The initial score seen is the score that reflects the cumulative final grade reflecting the 70/30 percent weight (70% exam and 30% homework). At the conclusion of the course, this grade will be recorded as the final grade **IF THE STUDENT HAS AN 80% OR GREATER IN EACH OF THE TWO CATEGORIES (EXAM AND HOMEWORK)**. **If the student has less than an 80% in either the exam or homework category** the final grade will be recorded as the category grade falling below 80%. The category grade falling below 80% will determine whether a "D" or "F" will be given for the course based on the nursing grading scale. This will be the grade recorded on the official transcript.

C (80.94%)

This is your cumulative grade based on the grades you have earned so far. This grade is based on the 70/30% weight. It may change as new grades are entered. The grade reflected here will only be your final grade at end of the course if you have 80% or greater in both the exam and homework categories.

If both the exam and homework categories are under 80% the cumulative grade reflecting the 70/30 weight will also fall under 80%. Therefore the cumulative grade will be entered as the final grade.

In the example given above, the final grade for the course would be a “D” because of the exam category score 76.2% based on the nursing grading scale.
