Overnight parking on Neosho County Community College's campus is by permit only and restricted to areas in parking lot #4 on the East side of Bideau Hall, designated by signs reading "Residence Hall Parking". Any overflow parking will be located in parking lot #3 on West side of Bideau Hall, designated by parking spaces painted with "Reserved Residents". The student will be issued a parking permit by a Safety Officer. Any student planning to keep a car in overnight MUST park in the designated area. Keeping public parking open in P3 is non-negotiable. It must be accomplished by everyone involved, especially the vehicle owners. Any questions or complaints can be voiced to the Safety Officer on duty. Cars parked in the designated resident parking areas must have permit visible in the front driver side windshield. Any vehicle that does not have a parking permit attached will be towed at the owner's expense. Any vehicle with a parking permit parked in an incorrect spot will be given a warning/ticket issued by the on duty Safety Officer.
