1. Assistant Director of Residence and Student life

It is my recommendation that the Board approve the employment of Hayley Stiger as the Assistant Director of Residence and Student Life. Ms. Stiger has an associate's degree in Sports Medicine from Neosho County Community College, and is enrolled in her last course for her Bachelor's degree in Health Management from Friends University. Her previous employment includes Server at Buffalo Wild Wings, and Student Assistant Trainer at Neosho County Community College.

Ms. Stiger will be paid an annual salary of \$25,000.00. Her start date will be July 18, 2022.

2. Assistant Baseball Coach – Part-time

It is my recommendation that the Board approve the employment of Dawson Ashmore as the Assistant Baseball Coach Part-time. Mr. Ashmore's previous employment

includes Student Assistant Baseball Coach at Allen County Community College and Gooseneck Paintline Employee at B&W Trailer Hitches.

Mr. Ashmore will be paid an annual salary of \$15,050.00. His start date will be August 15, 2022.

3. Coordinator of Residence and Student life

It is my recommendation that the Board approve the employment of Dawson Ashmore as the Coordinator of Residence and Student life. Mr. Ashmore's previous employment includes Student Assistant Baseball Coach at Allen County Community College and Gooseneck Paintline Employee at B&W Trailer Hitches.

Mr. Ashmore will be paid an annual salary of \$12,480.00. His start date will be August 8, 2022.
