
Public Wireless Instructions


Users who are not employees or students, such as community members or guests on campus, can connect to NCCC_PUBLIC for wireless access. This requires you to register for access and self-registration requires a cell phone. If you do not have a cell phone, access codes are available upon request from the CLC in Chanute or the TLC in Ottawa.

To gain access to the NCCC_PUBLIC network, follow these steps:

Upon connecting to the NCCC_PUBLIC network, most devices will bring up the registration screen automatically. If your device does not, try opening your browser and browsing to any website and it should automatically redirect you to the registration site as seen below.



If you already have your access code (you received one from the TLC or CLC already) you can enter that here on the page and should be connected after sign in. If you need to self-register, hit the REGISTER FOR INTERNET ACCESS link. You will be prompted to enter your name, email, and phone number for registration as seen below. The cell phone number should be entered with no dashes, periods, etc. Example: 6204312820



Once you hit SAVE, you should receive a text message to the cell phone number you registered above with the login information. It should look something like this:

NCCC Public WiFi Access:
Username is "6203630554" ::
Password is "bOXYKKK4". Account is valid for 24 hours. Registration will be required at expiration.

Go back to the original login page and enter the credentials you received via text message. You should now be able to access the internet.
